

MAIDSTONE RUGBY

Holiday Draw

In these Terms and Conditions, "Maidstone Rugby Club" means Maidstone Football Club (registered under the Co-operative and Community Benefit Society Act 2014 number 29333R); the term "ticket" refers to the randomly assigned number(s) that will be allocated to each of the entrants upon purchase; the "Website" means the Club's website at <http://www.maidstonerugby.org.uk>

- The purchase of one 'number' entitles the player to one randomly assigned number for a chance in the relevant draw. All tickets will be the same price each. (Currently £5). There will be an admin fee of £1 per transaction online, which will be paid for by the club.
- This draw is open to all residents of mainland Great Britain (this excludes Northern Ireland, Isle of Man and Channel Islands)
- Underage gambling is an offence.
UK law states that it is an offence for raffle tickets to be sold to, by or on behalf of a person under 16 years of age. Maidstone Rugby Club's rules however state that players must be 18 or over to enter our raffle. Therefore, if a ticket is sold to, by, or bought on behalf of a person under the age of 18 they will be exempt from the draw and will not be awarded any prize.
- Monies raised by this draw will be set aside for projects that benefit all members of Maidstone Rugby Club.
- Payment for participation in the draw can be made online via the Maidstone Rugby Club website, using a credit/debit card **or** in person at the bar via cash/a credit/debit card from the months of September to February. We discourage sending cash in the post as this is insecure.
- Maidstone Rugby Club accepts no responsibility for any form of receipt of transaction being lost, damaged, illegible, or from which the prize-winner cannot be identified.
- Any ticket payments received after the draw will be considered as donations to Maidstone Rugby Club.
- Winning number will be drawn randomly.
- The first number drawn will win the prize of up to £1,000 in the form of a TUI Gift Card.
- For any prize being less than £1,000 it will be communicated up to 1 month prior to the draw, and will be based on monies received overall by participants, less 10% for club usage.
- The TUI Gift Card will be purchased by the club and sent to/given to the winner, with conditions of;
 - The card can be used as full or part payment for travel products at all TUI travel shops and superstores, excluding Southern Ireland
 - The card can't be used as payment, or exchanged for, travel money-related products, including currency, travellers' cheques and prepaid cards.
 - The card can't be exchanged for cash or to buy another gift card.
 - The expiry date will be printed on the reverse of your gift card. Your gift card expiry date will be at least 1 year from the date of the draw. For egift cards the expiry will be printed on the egift card and is 2 years from the date of the draw.
 - The card must be treated as cash, and the balance can't be refunded if it's lost, stolen or destroyed.
 - You can find out your balance by phone, in-store or on the web.
 - Cards can't be redeemed over the phone.
 - The card will not be applicable for shops in Southern Ireland, or online for TUI Ski, TUI Lakes, TUI Worldwide or First Choice Ski.
- The result of the draw is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- The winner will be notified by post, email or telephone as soon as possible after the draw date.
- Winners name will be published at www.maidstonerugby.org.uk.
- Where Maidstone Rugby Club is unable to contact the prize-winner so that a prize remains unclaimed for six months following Maidstone Rugby Club's first attempt to notify the prize-winner, Maidstone Rugby Club may apply the prize as it sees fit, including by re-offering the prize in future raffles.
- The winner is required to co-operate with Maidstone Rugby Club requirement to publish their win as and where deemed appropriate, and to provide proof of age when requested
- In the event of an error, howsoever caused, whether a printing error or otherwise and whether obvious or otherwise, which affects the draw in any way, the organisers reserve the right to fairly administer the draw as though the error had not occurred. Where the organisers deem it appropriate and/or feasible, Maidstone Rugby Club will notify entrants of the error.
- Failure to comply with any of these rules may result in the disqualification of the entry.
- Organisers reserve the right to disqualify any entry at their absolute discretion.
