1) Timings

1130 Vase Final Pitch 3 (located to rear of clubhouse)

1230 Salver Final Pitch 2 (pitch parallel to A2)

1330 Shield Final Pitch 1 (main pitch)

1500 Plate Final Pitch 2

1630 Cup Final Pitch 1

Changing Room facilities will be allocated on the day. Please encourage your team to shower and change as quickly as possible to allow us to clean through in preparation for the next team in.



2) Parking

THERE IS NO PARKING IN CANTERBURY RUGBY CLUB EXCEPT DISABLED AND PASS HOLDERS

We would like the organisation of this event to **leave as small a carbon footprint as possible**. Could we encourage you to organise car sharing schemes wherever possible. Coaches will be parked on site. There will be parking attendants on hand. If you plan to arrive by coach can you please provide us with advance notice.

We encourage you to be parked early leaving plenty of time to get from your car to the club



Parking will be in St David's Field located off the B2068 Nackington Road. See map below. For SAT NAV use the club postcode CT4 7AZ and you'll see the field a short distance from the club entrance.

3) Entrance Fee

There will be an entrance fee of £3 per adult as dictated by the county; the only exceptions are for teams, officials, and County members on production of the County handbook. For this you will receive a printed programme with the order of play. In order to save time can those spectators travelling by coach ensure that entrance monies are collected on the coach and handed in at the gate.

4) Touchline Rules

All pitches will be roped off, we ask that everyone keeps back behind the ropes to let the referee see the touch lines and get on with the game. This applies to coaches and subs as well, only touch judges will be allowed along the touch lines.

Please treat all the players, coaching staff and referees as you would expect to be treated yourself. No abuse, generous applause and respect to all. Abuse will not be tolerated.



5) Food & Drink

The club house facilities will be available from 1000 onwards serving food & drink. The club bar will be open for stronger refreshments.

6) Rubbish

Please do not drop litter around the club grounds. Please use the rubbish bins dotted around the grounds.

7) Alcohol

No alcohol to be brought onto the site.

8) Entertainment

There will be a band in the clubhouse from 1800.
